**MAGELLAN PROFILE UPDATING:** The courses on your Main Magellan profile that appear in 2017–2018 **DO NOT** automatically get shifted to 2018-2019. As you are on PEY during the 2017-2018 academic year, **you must remember to shift the courses you originally planned to take in 2017–2018 to the next academic year.** This will ensure that these courses remain on your “Main” profile and do not get overwritten by the course you are in this year, namely PEY500Y1. You can always revise your course selection prior to Magellan being locked. **\*Locking occurs every February to July for preregistration.\***

**TAKING CS/HSS COURSES WHILE ON PEY:** Students are allowed to take **evening courses** offered by Arts and Science while on PEY (*HSS/CS electives*) without formal approval. **Remember!** Not all A&S courses are considered to be CS or HSS. **It is your responsibility to ensure that the courses you take are acceptable to use to meet graduation requirements.
