GRAD CHECKS FOR 4TH YEAR STUDENTS

If you have not yet done so, come into the Undergraduate Office (SF B600) to confirm that you are on track to graduate! The Undergraduate Office uses your Magellan profiles to verify your ability to graduate.

Your Main profile must be up-to-date before seeking a graduation check.

If not updated, please create an alternate profile with your current courses.

CONVOCATION 2018 ELIGABILITY

To ensure placement in the June 2018 Convocation, submit your 600 hours forms ASAP.

It typically takes 2 to 4 weeks to process/approve hours.

Students who do not have their hours processed/approved by May 10, 2018 risk not being eligible for the June 2018 Convocation Ceremony.

MAGELLAN COURSE PRE-REGISTRATION: Pre-registration ended February 1st.

Main profiles are now LOCKED until July. During this time, you will not be able to revise your **main profile** (which is the profile we use). **ECE courses** on **valid main profiles** will be considered for pre-registration. Alternate profiles can be created for testing purposes only. *Click here for information previously sent out regarding valid/invalid profiles.* Remember:

- Changes you make to main profiles after they are unlocked in July will not be uploaded as they will not include pre-registered information.**
- The courses you select now are not final. You can make changes to your course selection when registration opens on ACORN (space permitting). Any changes you make will not have been included with preregistration numbers. Remember to test out any possible changes by creating alternate Magellan profiles to see if you still meet program and CEAB requirements.
- > Conflicts are unavoidable with a flexible curriculum. Magellan will not guarantee a conflict-free schedule.
