### **MAGELLAN COURSE PRE-REGISTRATION: Pre-registration ended January 31, 2019.**

**Main profiles are now LOCKED until July.** During this time, you will not be able to revise your **main profile** (which is the profile we use). **ECE courses on valid main profiles** will be considered for pre-registration. #### **Remember:**

- **Changes** you make to **main profiles** after they are unlocked in July will **not** be uploaded as they were not included in the pre-registered information.\*\*
- **The courses you select now are not final.** You can make changes to your course selection when registration opens on ACORN (space permitting). **Any changes you make will not have been included with pre-registration numbers.** Remember to test out any possible changes by creating alternate Magellan profiles to see if you still meet program and CEAB requirements.
- **Conflicts are unavoidable with a flexible curriculum.** Magellan will not guarantee a conflict-free schedule.
