#### MAGELLAN COURSE PRE-REGISTRATION: Pre-registration ended January 31, 2019.

Main profiles are now LOCKED until July. During this time, you will not be able to revise your main profile (which is the profile we use). ECE courses on valid main profiles will be considered for preregistration. Alternate profiles can be created for testing purposes only. Click here for information previously sent out regarding valid/invalid profiles.

# Remember:

- Changes you make to main profiles after they are unlocked in July will not be uploaded as they were not included in the pre-registered information.\*\*
- The courses you select now are not final. You can make changes to your course selection when registration opens on ACORN (space permitting). Any changes you make will not have been included with pre-registration numbers. Remember to test out any possible changes by creating alternate Magellan profiles to see if you still meet program and CEAB requirements.
- Conflicts are unavoidable with a flexible curriculum. Magellan will not guarantee a conflict-free schedule.

**PEY FINAL REPORT:** Your PEY Final Report is due at the end of your internship. Please refer to the <u>Engineering Career Centre website (PEY)</u> for information on what should be included on your final report as well as how it should be submitted. Students who do not submit a final report to the PEY office will <u>not</u> receive Credit for PEY on their transcript.




