

## Application Process for ECE students

### Interested in Going on Exchange in Winter 2027

1. Second year students interested in going on exchange in Winter 2027 can watch CIE's [How to Get Started Info Session videos](#) (part 1 & part 2) to learn how to submit the exchange application.
2. Students should consult the Department's Associate Chair, Undergraduate before submitting the exchange application if they have any questions or concerns.
3. Students must complete the [online application](#) by **April 8, 2026**.
  - Exchange applications will require students to list their top 3 destinations on their application.
  - If NTHU is the only option, select any institution as the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> choices and indicate "I am only interested in my primary choice." in the Study Plan section.
4. CIE will then notify the students of the nomination decision and give instructions on how to apply to the host institution in June 2026.
5. Students will have 7 – 10 business days to accept or decline the nomination.
6. Students who are accepting the nomination must:
  - ✓ Complete the application for NTHU as soon as possible but no later than mid-October.
  - ✓ Start working on U of T Safety Abroad requirements<sup>i</sup> and complete by Dec 2026 - Jan 2027.
  - ✓ Obtain course pre-approvals from the Department's Associate Chair, Undergraduate.
7. As soon as an admission letter is received from NTHU, students will apply for a visa.
